Before taking office as CEO, João Falcato held the following positions at the same institution: he was Director of Biology and responsible for Exhibitions, Quarantine, the Laboratory, the Collection, Veterinary medicine, Engineering and Maintenance and the Nautical Centre (2003/2006); General Curator (2001/2003), Exhibition Curator (1999/2001); Supervisor of Habitats and Gallery Tanks (1998/1999); and Aquarist (1997). Before joining the team at the Oceanário, he worked for the companies CON-AQUA and NECTON.

During this time, João Falcato has given talks at and/or organized international meetings (Conference of the European Union of Aquarium Curators, 2005; 1st World Aquality Symposium, 2004), and has also worked with organizations in the sector in the following capacities: co-coordinator of the European programme of conservation of public aquariums, European Union of Aquarium Curators (EUAC), since 2007; member of the team of inspectors of the Iberian Association of Zoos and Aquariums, between 2004 and 2007; member of the Joint Directorate of the Iberian Association of Zoos and Aquariums, between 2004 and 2007; and member of the Directorate Committee of EUAC, since 2003.
