Luísa Schmidt is a Sociologist, Senior Researcher at the Institute of Social Sciences – University of Lisbon. She particularly runs studies on Sociology of the Media and Environmental Sociology (PHD, 1999). At the ICS-UL she leads the Research Line on “Sustainability: Environment, Risk and Spaces”. She’s also the coordinator of OBSERVA - *Observatório Permanente de Ambiente, Sociedade e Opinião Pública*, a research program on environment, society, and public opinion, founded in 1996. At the OBSERVA she has run and co-ordinated a lot of researches on this field, e.g., nationwide surveys on environmental values and policy issues; on local administration, sustainable development, and environmental policy at the local level; on environmental education; on natural parks and water issues; on environment and the media, and so on, which allowed her a lot of publications.
